You will need to record the Range Statements Covered for each of the procedures you complete during your training and case study completion. For most of the treatments you will complete, you will cover several of the different range statements.

You must cover **ALL** of the Range Statements listed below within your treatment provision. If you have not been able to address one of the Ranges in practice due to client or product constraints then you should refer to your course tutor who will address this by oral or written assessment.

PLEASE NOTE - For the competent provision, and successful examination, of blemish removal IT IS VITAL that you practice the removal of each type of lesions as much as possible and beyond the mandatory requirement outlined in this document.

Telangiectasia – Face	6 Clients
Spider Naevi	1 Lesion
Small Cherry Angioma – up to 2mm diameter	2 Lesions
Medium Cherry Angioma – 2mm – 5mm	2 Lesions
Small Skin Tag – Up to 2 mm in length	2 Lesions
Medium Skin Tag - 3 - 5mm in length	2 Lesions
Large Skin Tag – Over 5 mm in length	1 Lesion
Small Seborrheic Keratosis - up to 5mm diameter	2 Lesions
Medium Seborrhiec Keratosis – over 5mm diameter	2 Lesions
Milia	4 Lesions
Sebaceous Hyperplasia	1 Lesion
Solar Lentigo	4 Lesions
Wart or Verruca	1 Lesion

- White Nozzle	1 Treatment
- Blue Nozzle	1 Treatment

- Freeze – Thaw-Freeze-Technique	1 Treatment
